II. Terms and Conditions :-

1. The User Agency shall pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined as per decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
2. The extraction of the trees /poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Divisional Forest Officer concerned on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Director, Social Forestry J&K, Jammu/Srinagar. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be paid by the User Agency directly to the agency executing the extraction.
3. The User Agency has made the payment in full as reported by the Nodal Officer, FCA vide letter dated 18-11-2016.
4. The User Agency and or its contractors will not bring any forest area under their use, other than the actual area / activity approved by the Government for the instant proposal. Any laxity or deviation on this account by the user agency or its contractors will attract penal provisions of the relevant Acts / legal provisions
5. Under the Compensatory Afforestation scheme, special emphasis will be given on plantation of Khair trees.
6. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
7. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.


