(C) Terms and Conditions:-

- 1. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 2. The user Agency and /or its contractors will not bring any forest area under their use, other than the actual area/activity approved by the Government for the instant proposal. Any laxity or deviation on this account by the User Agency or its contractors will attract penal provisions of the relevant Acts/legal provisions.
- 3. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- 4. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
- 5. The construction shall be allowed on forest land only after payment of amount summarized above to the Forest Department and when Government sanction is issued in the case.
- 6. The user agency shall pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined as per decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
 - 7. (i) The extraction of the trees/poles/saplings shall be done by the J&K Forest Development Corporation/Divisional Forest Officer concerned on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The marking for tree felling will be done in consultation with the user agency and effort shall be made to save maximum number of trees/poles/saplings. The cost of extraction shall be paid by the user agency directly to the agency executing the extraction.
 - (ii) The fundamental rule for marking of trees, enumerated during processing of the proposals, will be to save maximum number of trees without compromising with the construction and maintenance of the approved project structure and no trees/poles/saplings will be felled/cut/pruned/lopped for purposes/project activities other than those approved/sanctioned.
 - 8. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls on forest land and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction.
 - 9. The Transplantation of Poles (10-20 Cm) shall be done by the user agency in nearby degraded forest areas in consultation with the Forest Department.
 - 10. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its contractors shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times as per the standard rate of 2018 issued vide the Government Order No: 10-FST of 2018 dated: 09.01.2018.
 - 11. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.
 - 12. The user agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.

As and when asked for an amount of Rs 60,21,17,149/- on account of various heads as detailed in 13. summary table above shall be paid/credited through e-transaction into the account of the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K under intimation to the Nodal officer (FCA). 14.

The approval will remain valid for one year and in case the due amount against the project summarized above is not paid within the stipulated period i.e, from that date when user agency is

asked to deposit the due amount, the approval shall be deemed to have been cancelled.

The User Agency shall abide by the terms and conditions being imposed by the SBWL/NBWL 15. while issuing Wildlife Clearance.


