NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT)

On behalf of the Governor of J&K State sealed tender duly affixed with revenue stamps worth Rs 5/- are invited from the contractors dealing in MFPs for auction of confiscated MFPs of different species on "as it is where it is" basis stored at **Forest Information Centre, Bikram Chowk, Jammu (J&K)**. The tenders should reach in the office of the Conservator of Forests, East Circle Jammu by or before **30th of March 2016 by 12:30 P.M** which shall be opened on the same day at **1:00 P.M** by the Committee constituted by the Government vide Order No. 60 FST of 2008 Dated 13-02-2008. The detail of MFPs is as under:-

The following terms & conditions shall be prospective/successful tenderers:-

1. The different species of MFPs have been placed in lots from **1 to 16** of particular weight in the MFP Godown, Pulpar Jammu. The interested bidder may inspect the stocks of MFPs on any working day between 10:00 A.M to 4:00 P.M before start of the auction.
2. The tender should be written in Ink and legible hand. Tender Forms found to be over written, rubbed, tampered or defaced shall be rejected on the spot.
3. Conditional tenders will not be accepted/ entertained.

4. The tender forms can be obtained from the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Urban Forestry Division, Jammu against the cash payment of **Rs 200/-** on any working day **upto 12:00 Noon sharp of 30th of March 2016.**
5. Each participant will tender for the material in lots as mentioned in the lot lists which will be made available to all the participants two days before the tender. The highest bid for each lot shall be accepted. The Department of Forests, however reserves the right to reject any offer or with hold the auction without assigning any reason thereof.
6. The rate offered by the tenderer shall be exclusive of all taxes/surcharge. The taxes admissible under rule shall be borne by the tenderer.
7. The intending tenderer shall be required to deposit earnest money in the shape of CDR/Bank Draft drawn in any Government recognized/Scheduled Bank of India, payable at Jammu, pledged to the name of Conservator of Forests, East Circle Jammu as under:-

8. The tender shall be opened by the Tender Opening Committee at **1:00 P.M** on **30th of March 2016** in presence of tenderers or their authorized representatives in the office of Conservator of Forests, East Circle Jammu.
9. Earnest money of the successful tenderer and second highest tenderer shall be retained and earnest money for the rest of the tenderers will be returned within a week's time after the tender proceedings are over.
10. The successful tenderers shall have to deposit 50% of total value of the consignment before the issuance of formal order by the Divisional Forest Officer, Urban Forestry Division, Jammu and the balance 50% immediately within seven days after the issuance of formal order for release of MFPs in favour of successful tenderers, failing which the CDR deposited & 50% advance paid shall be forfeited in favour of the Forest Department..
11. Interest @ 9% per annum shall be charged for late payment if, any.
12. No Govt. transport/labour shall be provided to lift the auctioned MFPs
13. In case more than one tenderer offers the same highest bid for a particular lot, the Tender Opening Committee may take decision after due negotiation with the other highest bidders.
14. Black listed contractors/defaulters and Government debtors are not permitted to participate in the tendering process for which the tenderer should enclose an affidavit with his tender.

15. The stocks have to be lifted in the position as they are on the ground (both in quality & quantity) i.e "as it is where it is basis".
16. The buyer in whose favour the MFPs is finally allotted will have to intimate the location of Godown/Store in writing to Divisional Forest Officer of area, if he wants to store his purchased stocks within the jurisdiction of State till its final disposal.
17. The purchaser will not mix the purchased quantity of MFPs with already procured stocks without giving prior information to Divisional Forest Officer concerned.
18. Any other condition that the Department may like to impose shall be announced on the date of opening the tenders and shall be binding on the tenderers.


19. **ELIGIBILITY OF PARTICIPATION**

All those persons who deal in MFPs & the representatives of the State Forest Corporation duly authorized by MD SFC are also eligible to participate in the said auction.

20. **GENERAL**

- (a) Any dispute arising between the purchaser and the Forest Department shall be solved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu whose decision shall be final and binding on both parties.
 - (b) The successful bidder after having deposited all the dues to Divisional Forest Officer Urban Forestry Division Jammu, the transportation permission shall be accorded as warranted under rules and the successful bidder shall lift the consignment within 30 days from the issuance of formal order, failing which Rs 10/Kg/day shall be charged as rental charges.
 - (c) Any other condition, if found necessary shall be announced before the commencement of the auction of the notified date.
21. Any other guidelines, if found necessary shall be announced before the commencement of the auction of the notified date.
