


**Salient Points discussed in CAMPA Meeting called by Hon'ble Forest  
Minister, MoEF&CC on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2019**

1. Key objectives of APOs should be :
  - i. Soil and Moisture Conservation along with ANR/ Artificial regeneration as per prescriptions of Working Plan.
  - ii. Promotion of fodder also should be one of the key objectives along with fruit bearing trees.
  - iii. APOs should be prepared in consultation with Panchayats/ VFCs.
  - iv. APOs should also address problems of Invasive alien species.
  - v. Department to undertake concentrated work so as to demonstrate good work in minimum time.
  - vi. DRONE survey for CAMPA works. (It gives better reporting of performance during and after planting, rather than Satellite based monitoring).
  - vii. CAMPA APOs must have five years maintenance provision.
  - viii. Real time dynamic monitoring of CAMPA plantation.  
*By Forest Survey of India, Dehradun (FSI Cell in each state/ UT)*
  - ix. Making of successful APOs. Please ensure the following:
    - a) KMZ file should match the objectives, especially with respect to forest density vis-a-vis intervention.
    - b) Compliance to Compensatory Afforestation Fund (CAF) Rules, 2018.
    - c) Contingency should be embedded within APOs.
    - d) Implementing Agencies to make sure that CAMPA (NPV) money is utilized in best manner taking all steps to ensure correct usage of this money.
    - e) Due cognizance be taken for all orders, directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court on utilization, Monitoring & Evaluation of CA and NPV.
