Subject:- Guidelines for movement of the harvest of trees grown in orchards and private plantations.

In the back drop of Govt. Order No: 198FST of 2006 dt: \$\omegainsquare\$4/-2006, the issue has been discussed in the meeting held on 18-1-2007 attended to by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kashmir/Chief Conservator of Forests Jammu, Director, SFP, Chief Conservator of Forests (Central) and Sr. Law Officer o/o Pr.CCForests, After detail deliberations regarding movement of burest of trees grown on private lands exempted under the Govt. Order and on the basis of the consensus view, the following guidelines are hereby issued:-

- The grower/buyer/owner of the specie shall give declaration on plain paper giving the following information duly attested by Lambardar of the concerned village under his sign and seal:
 - i. Name, parentage and residential address of the grower.
 - ii. No of trees felled with specie and girth, location of the area/ Khasara No: name of the village.
 - iii. The number of logs and/or approximate quantity of firewood etc
 - iv. Destination
- The declaration duly attested by the concerned village Lambardar and countersigned, free of any charges by the Block Forester of the area should be submitted to the first forest check post enroute.
- The incharge check post shall after proper verification, enter the details of such transportation in a separate register mentioning name of the owner, specie, Khasara No. Source, destination, quantity and put necessary stamp on the declaration free of any charges.
- 4) The incharge checkpost shall send monthly details of such transportation to the concerned Range Officer who in turn shall submit consolidated monthly details of his Range to the Divisional Forest Officer concerned.
