Sub: Approval for Annual Plan of Operations for FY 2022-23 under CAMPA.

Sir,

The Annual Plan of Operations of J&K CAMPA for FY 2022-23 were considered in the meetings of the Executive Committee of National Authority, Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, held on March 10th & 15th and June 1st, 2022. In all, approval of the National Authority for, inter-alia, following activities (the revised proposals submitted on the CAMPA portal) have been received:-

1. All proposed works under Compensatory Afforestation (CA).
2. All proposed works under Additional CA
3. The Following works proposed under NPV:
 - a. Assisted Natural and Artificial Regeneration (fencing, fencing repair, planting, BUC, dibbling, patch sowing, grass slips in patches, MFP slips in patches, seed balls, plant production and plant maintenance) and silviculture operations in forests.
 - b. Fire management & control operations under NPV (fire line- new & maintenance, purchase of equipment and wages of fire watchers).
 - c. Soil & Moisture Conservation works in the forest.
 - DRSM and Crate works
 - WHS/Ponds/Gully plugging/ Biological Structures/Water holes/Percolation Trenches
 - Landslide treatment with earthen bags/Desilting.
 - d. Residential and office buildings for frontline staff (New buildings and Repair & renovation).
 - e. Protection of plantation and forests – Boundary Pillars installation.
4. For following activities in the APO, separate proposals need to be submitted, through proper channel, and approval shall be given on case to case basis: survey & mapping, modern nursery, purchase of forest protection equipment, construction of infrastructure like inspection path, walking trails & watch tower, training, documentation, publicity, awareness and miscellaneous works.
5. Immediate action must be taken for implementation of the approved APOs i.e. accord of administrative approval and technical sanction, tendering and award of contract in accordance with the relevant rules/guidelines issued by the competent authority, from time to time, without any further delay.
