Sub: Transfer of Forest Land to Army measuring 70 Acres,
15 kanals and 15 Marlas at Nihalpur Simbal Rakh
R.S.Pora.
Ref: Cabinet Decision NO:210/22 dated: 22-09-1997

Government order NO:436-FST of 1997
Dated: 30-09-1997.

Sanction is accorded to the transfer of Forest land measuring 70 Acres 15 Kanals and 15 Marla falling in the Forest Compartment NO:1,2,3 and 4 in Nihalpura Simbal Rakh, R.S.pura to Army on the following terms and conditions:-

- ix
1. The Army will not fell any tree coming in the area under their occupation since 1947 and the Forest Department shall have free access for inspection. The enumeration of trees shall be made jointly by the representatives of the Army and Forest Department and receipt of trees will be obtained from the user agency. For any damage to the Crop, the Army shall have to pay the cost plus ten times thereof as penalty.
 2. The cost of land as will be determined by the collector shall have to be paid by the Army for 70 Acres, 15 kanala and 15 Marlas.
 3. The arrears of rent for the Forest land measuring 70 Acres, 15 kanals and 15 Marlas under occupation since 1947 shall also be paid by the Army to Forest Department till the date of its formal handing over.
 4. The Army shall have to contribute towards the Compensatory Scheme for double the area so diversified at the rate of Rs. 10,000/- per Hac.

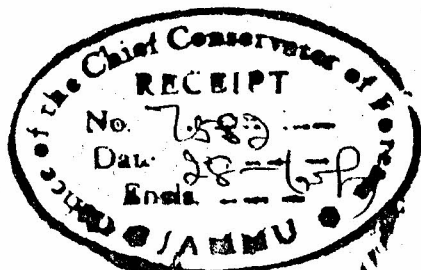
