Subject:- Transfer of Forest Land to Border Roads Task Force for widening of road from Chowkibal to Chamkote (Kamah) at Km. 0 to 15.

Reference:- Letter No. PCCF/NFP/Land/K/L/1483-85 dt; 28.6.1999 from Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.

Government Order No: 439 FST of 1999
Dated; 27 -10-1999.

Sanction is accorded to the transfer of Forest Land measuring (14.7 Hects) for widening of Road from Chowkibal to Chamkote(Kamah) from 0 to 15 Kms. in favour of Border Road Task Force, 56 APO on the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the cost of land involved (14.7 Hects) shall be recoverable as would be decided/assessed by the Revenue Authorities.
2. That the User Agency shall pay the compensatory afforestation to the tune of Rs.6.00 lacs.
3. That the User Agency will construct complete retaining/breast walls in the area along the road side so as to minimize the erosion/land slips.
4. That the compensation for removal of trees as assessed by the Chief Conservator of Forests Kashmir shall be paid by the User Agency.

The whole amount shall be deposited with the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 16th meeting held in Circulation.
