Sanction is accorded to the transfer of Forest land measuring 17.5 Hacters faling on Compartment NO: 10,11,21,22, 23 and 28 Kalidhar Forest Range of Jammu Forest Division in favour of 57-RCC GREF for construction/widening of Road from Tanda to Chowki-Choura on the following terms and conditions:-

> 1. That the GREF authorities will pay Rs. 86,62,276.60 as compensation of 631 trees involved in this alignment.

That the GREF authorities will pay Rs. 5,25,000.00 on account of compensatory afforestation works.

That the GREF authorities will pay the cost of X land as would be decided by the Revenue authorities.

4. That the status of Forest land will remain unchanged.

The whole amount shall be deposited with Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.

The proposal stand cleared/ approved by the Advisory Committee in its 16th meeting held in circulation.
