Sanction is accorded to the transfer of Forest
Land for non-forestry purposes measuring 5.17 hectas of Rajouri
Forest Division falling in comptt. NO. 76/R/97/R90, R & 99/R for
improvement of road from Rajouri to B.G. to N.H.D.L. specification
by the GREP authority on the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the GREP will pay the compensation for 278 trees of
different species to the extent of Rs. 228418/- (calculated
@ 2 times of the standard rate of 1992).
2. That the cost of land as would be assessed by the Revenue
deptt, shall be recovered from the GREP.
3. That the GREP will pay 2.20. lac toward compensatory
afforestation scheme.
4. That the proprietary status of Forest land shall remain
unchanged.
5. That any damage of trees done by the GREP will be charged
at cost plus ten times of the standard rate as
penalty.
6. That the GREP will construct complete retaining/breast walls
on both sides of roads so as to minimise soil erosion/Land
slips.
7. That the trees to be removed will be handed over to S^oC
for extraction.
