Sanction is accorded to the transfer of Forest
Land measuring 67 Kanals 10 Marlas falling in Comptt.64/R of
Rajouri Forest Division for construction of road Ghambir-Ghambra
FDL-640 Rajouri by GREF authorities on the following terms and
conditions:-

1. That the GREF will pay the compensation for 111 trees
of different species to the extent of Rs.60,560/-
(calculated @ 2 times of the standard rate of 1992).
2. That the cost of land as would be assessed by the Revenue
Dept., shall be recovered from GREF.
3. That the GREF authorities will pay Rs.4.92 lac towards
compensatory afforestation scheme.
4. That the proprietary status of forest land shall remain
unchanged.
5. That any damage of trees done by the GREF will be charged
at cost plus ten times of the standard rate as penalty.
6. That the GREF will construct complete retaining/breast walls
on both sides of roads so as to minimise soil erosion/
land slips.
7. That the trees to be removed will be handed over to SFC
for extraction.
