Subject: Forest Clearance case regarding upgradation/ improvement of road from Bhamla to Pouni JN specification to N.H. double lane.

Sanction is accorded to the transfer of Forest land as required under J&K Forest conservation Act for upgradation/Improvement of Road from Bhamla to Pouni JN from single lane class-09 specification to N.H. double lane by the 57 Road construction company (GREF). The area involved in the aforesaid construction is 1.36 hectares which falls in compt NO: 65/Takrakote in Reasi Forest Division on the following terms and conditions:

1. That the GREF authority will pay the compensation of trees as will be recalculated by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu at double the standard rates of 1992.
2. That the cost of land as would be assessed by the Revenue department shall be recovered from the user Agency.
3. That the GREF authorities will pay the cost of compensatory afforestation as would be worked out by the Chief Conservator of Forests.
4. That the proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
5. That any <sup>shd. be un-</sup> authorised damage of trees done by the user Agency will be charged at cost plus ten times of the standard rate as penalty.
6. That the User Agency will construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of roads so as to minimise soil erosion/land slips.
7. That the trees to be removed by User Agency will be handed over to SFC for extraction.
