- 2. The J&K Minerals Ltd. authorities will pay Rs. 2,88,000.00 on account of compensatory afforestation cost.
- 3. The J&K Minerals Ltd authorities will pay the cost of Forest land as may be assessed by the Revenue Department.
- 4. The royalty as would be decided by the Govt. for dispatches of Coal shall be borne by the J&K Minerals Ltd which will be paid by the user agency to the Forest Department.
