Transfer of Forest Land for non-forestry purposes construction of road from Jhulla to Daddal. Sub:-

Sanction is accorded to the Transfer of Forest land for non-forestry purposes measuring 5.0 Hects. falling in compartment No. 157,158/D of Nowshera Forest Division for construction of road from Jhulla to Daddal by Army authorities on the following terms & conditions:-

That the User Agencies will pay % 93,940 as the compensation for the trees of different species calculated @ two times the standard rate of 1992.

That the cost of the land as would be assessed by the Revenue Deptt. shall be recovered from the User Agency.

That the User Agency will pay Rs 1.50 lacs towards 3) compensatory afforestation.

4) That the propriatory status of forest land shall remain unchanged,

That any damage of trees done by the user Agency will be charged @ tem times of the standard rate

of 1992 as penalty. That the User Agency will construct complete retaining/breast walls on both sides of roads

and take other necessary steps, so as to minimise soil erosion/land slips. That the trees to be removed will be handed over

to SFC for extraction.

8) The amount received shall be utilized by Forest Department as provided W SRO 203 dated 13-04-2000.
