Sanction is accorded to the transfer of Forest Land
measuring 18.00 hec. falling in Comptt. Nos. 67, 68, 71/R of
Rajouri Forest Division for construction of FDL-495 Tarkundi Road

by the GLEF Authorities on the following terms and conditions :-

1. That the user agency will pay Rs 8,94,685 as the compensation for the trees of different species calculated @ two times the standard rate of 1992.
2. That the cost of the land as would be assessed by the Revenue Deptt. shall be recovered from the user agency.
3. That the user agency will pay Rs 3.38 lac towards compensatory afforestation.
4. That the proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
5. That any damage of trees done by the user agency will be charged @ ten times of the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
6. That the user agency will construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of roads and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips.
7. That the trees to be removed will be handed over to SEC for extraction.
8. The amount received shall be utilized by Forest Department as provided in SRO 203 dated 13-4-2000.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 19th meeting held on 31-7-2000.
