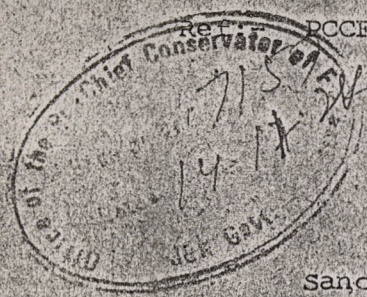

Sub:- Transfer of Forest Land for construction of Budhal - Mahore Road by GREF.

Govt. Order No. 454, FST of 2000

D a t e : 7 - 10 - 2000

Sanction is accorded to the transfer of Forest Land measuring 9.45 hect. passing through Comptt. Nos. 28, 29 and 59/AR of Mahore Forest Division in favour of GREF for construction of Budhal - Mahore road on the following terms & conditions :-

1. That the user agency will pay Rs 1,93,160 the compensation for the trees of different species calculated @ two times the standard rate of 1992.
2. That the cost of the land as would be assessed by the Revenue Department shall be recovered from the user agency.
3. That the user agency will pay Rs 5.88 lacs towards compensatory afforestation.
4. That the proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
5. That any damage of trees done by the user agency will be charged @ ten times of the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
6. That the user agency will construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of roads and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips.
7. That the trees to be removed will be handed over to SFC for extraction.
8. The amount received shall be utilized by Forest Department as provided in SRO 203 dated 13-4-2000.

The proposal stands already clarified/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 19th meeting held on 31-7-2000.
