

Subject: - Diversion of Forest land for improvement/widening
Kishtwar-Sinthan Road to National Highway.

GOVT. ORDER NO: 193 FST OF 2002
DATE: 12/4/2002.

Sanction is hereby accorded to the transfer of Forest land measuring 62.80 Ha passing through Compartment No. 76, 77, 78, 79a, 79b, 80a, 80b, 81a, 81b, 91b, 94b, 95b, 97c, 98b, 98c & 99a, 99c, 100 & 102 in Udil Range of Marwah Forest Division of Doda District in favour of 119 FOC (GREF) for improvement/widening of Kishtwar-Sinthan Top (0.82 Km) Road to National Highway on the following terms and conditions :-

1. That the proprietary status of Forest land shall remain un-changed.
2. That the Forest land shall be utilized only for the purposes for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of Forest Department.
3. That the Forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged re-assigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what-so-ever to any other agency.
4. That the user agency shall pay Rs. 2,90,41,000/- as compensation of land on account of change of land use assessed as equivalent to cost of land by Revenue Department.
5. That the user agency shall pay Rs. 5,26,00,000/- on account of compensation of trees to be felled @ two times the standard rate of 1992.
6. That the user agency shall pay Rs. 33,26,000/- on account of compensatory afforestation on degraded Forest land over twice the extent of Forest area being diverted.
7. That the user agency shall also pay Rs. 1,34,410/- on account of cost of structures viz. Barbed wire fence and posts falling in the alignment.
8. That the extraction of trees shall be done by the State Forest Corporation on the basis of marking list duly approved by Conservator of Forests, working plan and Research Circle.

9. That any damage done to the Forest by the user agency, its employees, contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
10. That the User Agency shall construct complete retaining/Breast wall on both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips.
11. That the Forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Deptt. when it is not required by the User Agency without any cost.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 21st meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 31-01-2002.
