GOVT. ORDER No. 195 FST of 2002

D a t e d : 72 - 04 - 2002

Sanction is hereby accorded to the transfer of Forest land measuring 9.6 Ha passing through Compartment No. 75, 76, 77/Khuihama of Bandipora Forest Division, District Baramulla for construction of Amar Akber Glyungali Operational Track by Army authorities on the following terms and conditions :-

1. That the proprietary status of Forest land shall remain un-changed.
2. That the Forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted and shall not be transferred to any other agency without the approval of the Forest Department.
3. That the Forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, sub-leased by user agency in any manner what-so-ever to any other agency.
4. That the user agency shall pay compensation of land on account of change of land use which shall be equivalent to cost of land as assessed by Revenue authorities.
5. That the user agency shall pay Rs. 3.15 lacs towards compensatory afforestation over degraded forest land to the extent of two times the Forest area being diverted.
6. That any damage to the forest done by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
7. That the Forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is not required by the user agency without any cost.

8. That the user agency shall construct retaining/breast walls on both sides of the road and take other necessary steps so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips.
9. That the amount received shall be utilized by Forest Department as provided in SRO:203 dated 13-04-2000.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 21st meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 31-01-2002.
