

Sanction is hereby accorded to the transfer of Forest Land measuring 4.858 Ha passing through Compartment No. 36/s, 39/s, 41/s, 42/s, 44/s and 45/s in South Range of Ramnagar Forest Division in favour of Public Works Department for construction of Marta to Thial via Chauntra Mata Road (km 9-27) on the following terms and condition-s:-

- That the proprietary status of Forest land shall remain un-changed.
- 2. That the forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it is diverted and shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
- 3. That the user agency shall pay compensation of trees to the extent of Rs. 12,68,720/- @ two times the standard rate of 1992.
- 4. That the user agency shall pay compensation for land as a result of change in land use to be calculated equivalent to cost of land, which shall be assessed by Revenue authorities.
- 5. That the user agency shall also pay an amount of Rs. 1.99 lacs for compensatory afforestation amount to be carried over 10 Ha of degraded Forest land.
- 6. That any damage of trees done by user Agency shall be charged @ 10 times of the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
- 7. That the user agency shall construct retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road and take all thm steps to minimize soil erosion/land slips.
- 8. That the extraction of trees shall be done by the State $^{\rm F}$ orest Corporation.
- 9. That the user agency shall deposit the amount of compensatory afforestation in the office of the Pr. Chief Conservaor of Forests J&K State in terms of SRO 203 dated 2 13-06-2000.
