GOVT. ORDER No. 205 FST of 2002

Sanction is hereby accorded to the transfer of
Forest land measuring 3,108 Ha passing through Comptt.No.
37, 38 and 42/P in Panchari Range of Udhampur Forest
Division in favour of Public Works Department for constr-
uction of Dobigali - Khorgali road (km 1-6) on the following
terms and conditions :-

1. That the proprietary status of Forest land shall remain un-changed.
2. That the Forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose of which it has been diverted and shall not be transferred to any other agency without the approval of the Forest Department.
3. That the Forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, re-assigned, sub-leased by user agency in any manner what-so-ever to any other agency.
4. That the user agency shall pay compensation of land on account of change of land use which shall be equivalent to cost of land as assessed by Revenue authorities.
5. That the user agency shall pay Rs. 8.07 lacs @ 2 times the standard rate of 1992 on account of compensation of trees to be felled.
6. That the user agency shall pay Rs. 1.45 lacs on account of compensatory afforestation over 6.5 Ha of degraded forest land.
7. That any damage done by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ ten times the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
8. That the Forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest deptt. when it is not required by the user agency without any cost.
9. That the extraction of trees shall be done by the State Forest Corporation. The marking list shall be duly approved by the Conservator of Forests Working Plan and Research Circle.

10. That the user agency shall construct retaining/breast walls on both sides of the road and take other necessary steps so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 21st meeting under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 31-01-2002.
