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Sub:- Diversion of 4.0 Ha. of Forest land for construction of operational Track From Berian to Glyun Gali passing through Compartment 78/NL in Northern Lolab Range of Kamraj Forest Division in Kupwara, District.

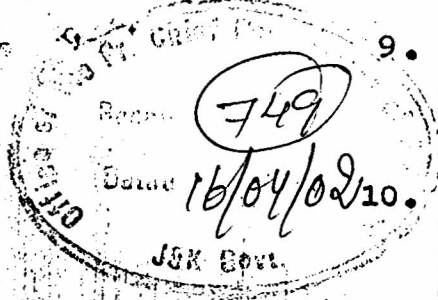
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Sanction is hereby accorded to the transfer of Forest land measuring 4.0 Ha. in Compartment No. 78/NL in North Lolab Range of Kamraj Forest Division, in District Kupwara in favour of Army for construction of operational Track from Berian to Glyun Gali on the following terms and conditions :-

1. That the proprietary status of Forest land shall remain un-changed.
2. That the Forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted and shall not be transferred to any other agency without the approval of the Forest Department.
3. That the Forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, re-assigned, sub-leased by user agency in any manner what-so-ever to any other agency.
4. That the user agency shall pay compensation of land on account of change of land use, which shall be equivalent to cost of land as assessed by Revenue authorities.
5. That the user agency shall pay compensation of trees @ 2 times the standard rate of 1992.
6. That the user agency shall pay Rs. 1.60 lacs for compensatory afforestation over degraded forest land to the extent of twice the Forest land being diverted.
7. That any damage done by user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
8. That the Forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is not required by the User agency without any cost.

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9. That the user agency shall construct retaining/breast walls on both sides of the road and take other necessary steps so as to minimize soil erosion/land slides.
10. That the extraction of trees shall be done departmentally. The marking lists be duly approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan & Research Circle.
11. That the amount received shall be utilized by Forest department as provided in SRO 203 dated 13-4-2000.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 21st meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 31-01-2002.
