Subject: - Diversion of Forest land for widening of existing Kishtwar-Dul-Galhar-Sansari road to National Highway D/L specifications by Project Beacon in Boda District.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. 340-FST of 2003

D A T E D : 17-07-2003

Sanction is hereby accorded to the transfer of Forest land measuring 111.407 hectare of forest area falling in comptt. NO. 65/Kishtwar, 7b, 8a, 10a, 12a, 16, 17, 19, 20c/ Nagani and 11ab, 12ab, 13, 17, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40a, 40b/Padder of Kishtwar Forest Division for widening of existing Kishtwar-Dul-Galhar-Sansari road to National Highway D/L specifications by Project Beacon in Boda District on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land so diverted shall be ~~is~~ utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what-so-ever to any other agency.
4. The user agency shall pay for compensation of land on account of change of land use which shall be equivalent to cost of land as assessed by competent Revenue authorities.
5. The user agency shall pay compensation of Rs. 1,06,79,947/- on account of compensation of 5423 trees @ two times standard rate of 1992.
6. The user agency shall also pay Rs. 13,64,166/- on account of compensation for additional trees marked in comptt. NO. 13/P due to change in alignment during construction of Gulabgarh-Sansari road.
7. The user agency shall also pay Rs. 44,56,230/- on account of compensatory afforestation over 223 Ha. of degraded forest land.

8. The user agency shall pay compensation of Rs.17,33,087/- on account of existing fencing coming in the alignment as well as checks posts at Gulabgarh.
9. The user agency shall also pay Rs.47,43,131/- for liabilities on account of compensation during the construction of Gulabgarh-Sansari road.
10. Any damage caused to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from user agency at the rate of ten times the standard rate of 1992.
11. The user agency shall will construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips.
12. The trees falling in the alignment shall be marked for extraction by SFC/Forest Department on the basis of marking list duly approved by CF, Working Plan Circle.
13. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is not required by the user agency without any costs.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory committee in its 23rd Meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 15.1.2003.
