

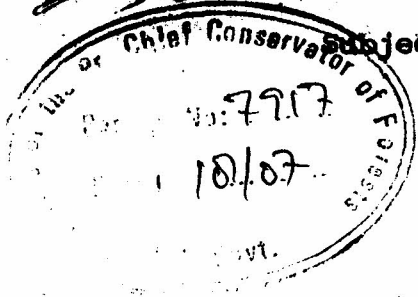

Subject:- Diversion of Forest Land for Construction of Maitra-Blout Road (1-7-Km phase-I) upto pouni by PWD (E&B) Division Ramban.

Sanction is hereby accorded to the transfer of Forest land measuring 2.60 hectare of Forest area falling in Comptt.No. 40b,41 and 43/Batote of Batote Forest Division for Construction of Maitra-Blout Road (1-7 Km Phase-I) upto Pouni by PWD (R&B) Div Ramban on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of the land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted and shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, sub-leased by user agency in any manner whatsoever to any other agency,
3. The user agency shall pay compensation of land on account of changed of land-use which shall be equivalent to cost of land as assessed by the competent Revenue Authorities.
4. The user agency shall pay an amount of Rs.7,85,165/- on account of compensation of 78 chir and 308 Broad leaved trees at the rate of two times the standard rates of 1992.
5. The user agency will pay an amount of Rs.79,750/- on account of compensatory afforestation over 5.3. ha degraded forest land.
6. The user agency shall pay an amount of Rs.6.672/- on account of cost of damages, relocation of fence lines etc (4 stand Barbed wire).
7. The user agency shall construct retaining/breast walls wherever required on both sides of the diverted forest land and take other steps so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips.
8. The extraction of trees shall be carried out by the SFC, Forest Department on the basis of marking list approved by the Conservator of Forests, Working plan Circle.

9. The user agency shall deposit the amount of compensatory afforestation in the office of the Pr.Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu and Kashmir in terms of SRO 203, Dated: 13.6.2000.
10. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is not required by the user agency without any cost.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 23rd Meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 15.1.2003.
