Sanction is accorded to the removal of 86 trees, from Forest area measuring 215.83 acres falling under Compartment No. 1-b Rakhs and Compartment No. 2-b Kuthar Range at Khundru Block in Tehsil and District Anantnag already transferred to Army authorities in pursuance of Govt. order NO. 21(G) of 1986 dated 5.11.1986 for construction of 6 Hqs (450 Mts each) and 14 types of Sheds (450 Mts each) and creation of additional infrastructure at 21 FAD Khundru, on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The extraction of timber shall be carried out Departmentally on marking list duly approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan and Research Circle.
2. All necessary steps shall be taken by the Army to prevent existing crop from fire/explosion damage due to the nature of works under taken.
3. Any further felling of trees shall require the approval of Forest Department.
4. The forest land shall return to Forest Department when it is no longer required by the User agency.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 22nd Advisory Meeting held on 16.08.2002.
