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GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. 210/FST of 2004

Sanction is hereby accorded to the transfer of forest
land measuring 7.434 hectares of forest area to be diverted
out of which 5.094 ha. falls in comptt. 93/K, 95/K, 96/K, and 97/K
in Reasi Forest Division and 2.34 ha. in Comptt. 2/Tunnel in
Jindrah Range of Jammu Forest Division for improvement of
Domail Katra road CL-9 to National Highway D/L specification
by P-roject Sampark on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner whatsoever to any other agency.
4. The user agency shall pay compensation of land on account of change of land use which shall be equivalent to the cost of land as assessed by Revenue Authorities. In Reasi Forest Division it has been worked out to Rs. 81,50,400/- which is to be paid by the user agency. However in Jammu Forest Division compensation towards cost of land is yet to be assessed by the Revenue Authorities. As and when this process is completed, the user agency shall be liable to make the payment.
5. The user agency shall pay Rs. 24,05,163/- on account of compensation of trees @ two times the standard rate of 1992.
6. The user agency shall pay Rs. 3,40,000/- towards compensatory afforestation to be carried over 15 ha. of degraded forest land as well as planting of ornamental plants on both sides of the road.

7. The user agency shall pay Rs. 4,41,000/- for dismantling/ removal of fencing of closures along road side due to widening of road.
8. The user agency shall pay Rs. 3,00,000/- for fresh construction of Moori Check Post falling in the road alignment.
9. The user agency shall construct complete retaining/breast walls on both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slides.
10. The extraction of trees shall be done by SFC/Forest Deptt on the basis of marking list duly approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan and Research Circle.
11. Any damage caused to the forest by the user agency or its employees, contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ ten times the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
12. The forest land so diverted shall ~~be~~ returned to the Forest Department without any costs when it is no longer required by the user agency.
13. The user agency shall deposit the amount of compensatory afforestation in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K Government, as per SRO-203 dated 13.04.2000.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 25th Meeting held on 09.02.2004, under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary.
