Subjects- Diversion of Forest Land for construction of approach road from Kanthan to Kauri by M/S Kenkan Railways Corporation.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. 341-FST of 2004

Sanction is ~~XXXX~~ accorded to the diversion of Forest Land measuring 2.0275 Ha. of forest area falling in Comptt. NO. 99/Arnas for construction of approach road from Kanthan to Kauri of Mahora Forest Division by M/S Kenkan Railways Corporation on the following terms and conditions:

1. The proprietary status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, re-assigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what-so-ever to any other agency.
4. The user agency shall pay compensation of land as would be assessed by the Revenue authority, however the land shall not be transferred to the user agency until the compensation on account of land use is not paid in advance and in full.
5. The user agency shall pay Rs. 5,12,000/- towards compensation of 707 trees of different species and dia classes @ two times of the standard rate of 1992.
6. The user agency shall pay Rs. 51,000/- towards compensatory Afforestation to be carried over 4.04 Ha of degraded forest land.
7. The user agency shall construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slides. In this regard, the user agency shall seek technical guidance from Director, Soil Conservation & Department, J&K Govt.
8. The extraction of trees shall be done departmentally by SFC/Forest Department on the basis of marking list duly approved by Conservator of Forests Working Plan and Research Circle.

9. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees, contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ ten times the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
10. The forest land so diverted shall return to the forest department, when it is no longer required by the user agency without any cost.
11. The user agency shall deposit the amount of Compensatory Afforestation in the office of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests J&K Govt. as per SRO-203 dated 13.04.2000. The compensation of the trees felled and the compensation for any damage shall be deposited with the DFO Mahara.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 26th Meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 03.07.2004.
