Subject:- Diversion of Forest land for construction of  
Railway line Ratna to Gagium (Marotkote to Gran  
Section) by Indian Railways.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. 346-FST of 2004

D A T E D : 05.08.2004

Sanction is hereby accorded to the diversion of forest  
land measuring 43.78 Ha. falling in compartment No. 25 and  
37/Rani of Forest Division Rani for construction of  
Railway line Ratna to Gagium (Marotkote to Gran Section)  
by Indian Railway on the following terms and conditions:

1. The proprietary status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged re-assigned or sub-leased by the user agency in any manner what-so-ever to any other agency.
3. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
4. The user agency shall pay Rs. 36,35,090/- towards compensation of land on account of change of land use which is equivalent to the cost of land as already assessed by the Revenue Authorities.
5. The user agency shall pay Rs. 18,91,193/- towards compensation of 7844 number of trees of different species and 448-classes @ two times of the standard rate of 1992.
6. The user agency shall pay Rs. 21,92,468/- towards compensatory Afforestation to be carried over 87.71 Ha. of degraded forest land.
7. The user agency shall construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slides. In this regard, the user agency shall seek technical guidance from Director Soil Conservation Department, JK Govt.
8. The extraction of trees shall be done by SPC/Forest Department on the basis of marking list duly approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan and Research Circle.

9. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees, contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ ten times the amount of year of 1998 as penalty.

10. The diverted land or diversion shall return to the Forest Department, when it is no longer required by the User Agency without any cost.

11. The user agency shall deposit the amount of compensation mentioned in the office of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests J&K Govt. as per SRO 263 dated 12.04.2003. The compensation of the Forest land diverted, Compensation for the trees felled and the compensation for any damage shall be deposited with the DFO J&K.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 26th Meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 03.07.2004.
