Sanction is accorded to the transfer of forest land measuring 7,2 Ma.of forest area falling in Comptt.NO°s 7/BSB, 22/BSB, 23/BSB, 24/BSB, 25/BSB, 25/BSB, 27/BSB and 32/BSB of Billawar Forest Division for construction of Basoli-Bani-Banderwah mod ( Mm 00 to 89,00) for development to National Mighway Double Bane standards in Billawar Forest Division by 69 MCC(GREF) on the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The proprietary status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 3. The forest land so dive-rted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Repartment.
- 3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, re-assigned or sub-lessed by user agency in any manner what-se-ever to any other agency.
- 4. The user agency shall pay compensation of land on account of change of land use which shall be equivalent to the cost of land as assessed by Revenue Authorities. The CCF James, shall ensure that the assessment of land by Revenue Authorities is made at an earliest.
- 5. The user agency shall pay Rs. 2,36,272/- on account of a empensation of 598 number of trees of different species and different dis classes 0 two times of the standard rate of 1992.
- 6. The user agency shall pay Rs. 3,88,700/- on account of compensatory Afforestation to be carried over 1282 14.4 Ha.degraded forest land,
- 7. The user agency shall construct complete retaining/ breast walls on the both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/ land slides. In this regard, the user agency shall seek technical guidance from Director, Soil Conservation Department, Jak Government.
- The extraction of trees shall be done by SPC/Forest

  Deptt. on the basis of marking list duly approved by
  the Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle.

- 9. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees, contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency 0 ten times the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.
- The ferest land so diverted shall return to the Ferest Department when it is no longer required by the user agency without any cost.
- The user agency shall deposit the amount of compensation for the forest land diverted to be assessed by the Revenue Authorities, the compensation for 598 trees felled and compensation for the damage done with the BFO, Billawar. However the cost of compensatory afforestation shall be deposited with the Chief Secounts Officer, in the office of the Frincipal Chief Conservator of Forests, Jak Govt. as per 530-203 dated 13.04.2000.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 26th Meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 03.07.2004.
