Subject:- Forest clearance for construction of BGR CL-2 specification Road Saliyar Chatta in Rajouri Forest Division.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. 350-FST of 2004

D A T E D : 05.08. 2004

Sanction is accorded to the diversion of Forest land measuring 4.43 Ha. of Forest area falling in Compartment No. 150/Kalskote, Forest Division Rajouri for construction of BGR CL-2 specification Road Saliyar Chatta by 311 TRU AIR Force on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, re-assigned or sub-leased by the user agency in any manner what-so-ever to any other agency.
3. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
4. The user agency shall pay compensation of land on account of change of land use, which is equivalent to the cost of the land as would, assessed by the Revenue Authorities. The CCF Jammu shall ensure that the assessment of land by Revenue Authorities is made at an earliest.
5. The user agency shall pay Rs. 2,01,074/- towards compensation of 59 trees and 1500 Bushes of different species and dia-classes @ two times of the standard rate of 1992.
6. The user agency shall pay Rs. 1,00,000/- towards compensatory Afforestation Scheme to be carried over 9.00 Ha. degraded forest land.
7. The user agency shall construct complete retaining/breast walls on both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slides. In this regard, the user agency shall seek technical guidance from Director, Soil Conservation Department, J&K Govt.
8. The extraction of trees shall be done by SFC/Forest Department on the basis of marking list duly approved by the Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle.
9. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees, contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency @ ten times the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.

10. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department, when it is no longer required by the User Agency without any cost.
11. The user agency shall deposit the amount of compensator afforestation in the office of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K Govt. as per SRO-203 dated 13.04.2000. The compensation of the forest land diverted, compensation for the trees felled and the compensation for any damage shall be deposited with the DFO Rajouri.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 26th meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 03.07.2004.
