Subject:- Diversion of Forest land for Construction of Water Tank on Rajouri Budhal road side at Army in Rajouri Forest Division.

Reference:- Cabinet Decision NO. 185/9 dated 25.10.2004.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. YOO/FST OF 2004

Sanction is accorded to the diversion of Forest Land measuring 25 Sq.MT in Rajouri Forest Division for construction of Water Tank on Rajouri Budhal road side at Palma by Army in Rajouri Forest Division on the following terms and conditions:-

The proprietary status of the forest land shall remain unchanged. 1.

2. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.

3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by the user agency in any manner whatsoever to any other agency.

4. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees, contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency (a) ten times the standard rate of 1992 as penalty.

5. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department, when it is no longer required by the user agency, without any costs.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 26th meeting held under the Chairmanship of Financial Commissioner, Planning & Dev. Department on 03.07.2004.
