**Subject: Diversion of Forest Land for construction of Kastigarh link road under J&K Forest conservation Act.**

Government Order No: 387 FST of 2005

Dated: 29-09-05

Sanction is hereby accorded to the diversion of forest land measuring 2.86 hectares of forest land falling under compartment No.89/Siraj of Siraj Range, Dhaindal Block, Forest Division Doda for construction of kastigarh link road by Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Spl. Sub. Div. Doda on the following conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. The User Agency shall pay compensation of forest land 2.86 hac as would be calculated by the concerned DFQ as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 30-10-2002 in I.A. No: 566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No: 202 of 1995.
5. The User Agency shall be bound to pay an amount of Rs. 3,50,922/- on account of compensation of 177 Nos. of trees/poles of different species and dia-classes.
6. The User Agency shall pay Rs. 65,640/- on account of compensatory afforestation to be carried over 5.72 ha of degraded forest land.
7. The extraction of trees shall be done by the SFC/Forest Department on the basis of marking list approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle.
8. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency at the rate of ten times of the standard rate of 1992.
9. The user agency will construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips.
10. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is no longer required by the User Agency without any cost.
11. The user agency shall get done Environment Impact Assessment and also prepare the Environment Plan for submission of same to Forest Department before taking up of actual execution of work.
12. The user agency shall also pay any other amount which will become payable as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dt 30-10-2002 in I.A. No. 566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No: 202 of 1995 T.N. Godavarman Thirumalakpad V/S Union of India.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Adv. Committee in its 30<sup>th</sup> meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 16.8.2005.
