Subject: Permission for felling of 404 trees at Bari Brahmana Railway Station yard in connection with doubling of Jalandhar-Pathankote-Jammu Tawi Section.

Sanction is accorded to diversion of forest land measuring 1.5 hectares falling under the area is a Railway land in Bahu Range, Jammu Forest Division for permission of felling of 404 trees at Bari Brahmana Railway Station yard in connection with doubling of Jalandhar-Pathankote-Jammu Tawi Section by Dy.Chief Engineer, Northern Railways Jammu on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The user agency shall be bound to pay an amount of Rs.5,50,605/- (Rs. Five lacs fifty thousand six hundred & five only) on account of compensation of 404 Nos. of Broad leaves trees of different species and dia-classes.

2. The extraction of trees shall be done by the SFC/Forest Department on the basis of marking

list approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle.

Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency at the rate of ten times the standard rate of 1992.

4. The user agency shall also pay any other amount which will become payable as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court or Government/Forest Department, J&K.

5. The user agency shall be responsible to obtain requisite clearances under any other law in

vogue

6. The possession of Forest land diverted for non-forestry purpose or felling of trees under the orders of the competent authority, should not be handed over to the user agency or done till all payments due against Compensation of trees, NPV/Compensation of land, Compensatory afforestation costs etc are not deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the PCCF. Before allowing felling of trees it should be further ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said User Agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past.

The User Agency shall be bound to pay an amount of Rs. 75,000/- (Rs. Seventy five thousand only)

on account of Compensatory Afforestation for afforestation of 3 ha of forest land.

The proposal stands cleared/ approved by the Advisory Committee in its 36th Meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary.
