Subject:- Diversion of 0.030706 ha. of forest land for installation of Tower at Mand Hill Udhampur (measuring 59'x56') by Reliance Infocomm Ltd. in Udhampur Forest Division.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. 3/7 - FST OF 2007
D A T E D ; 06 - 06 - 2007

Sanction is accorded to diversion of forest land measuring 0.030706 ha falling under Compartment No. 17/U in Block Gudharsingal, Range Udhampur, Udhampur Forest Division for installation of Tower at Mand Hill Udhampur (Measuring 59'x56') by Infocomm Ltd on the following terms and conditions:

1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. The User Agency shall pay Net Present Value of the forest land to the tune of Rs. 17,809/- (Rupees Seventeen thousand eight hundred and nine only) as calculated by the concerned DFO as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 30.10.2002 in I.A. No. 566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202 of 1995 T.N. Godaverman Thirumalpad V/S Union of India.
5. The User Agency shall be bound to pay an amount of Rs. 30,280/- (Rupees Thirty thousand two hundred and eighty only) on account of compensation of 4 number of Chir trees of different dia-classes.
6. The extraction of trees shall be done by the SFC/Forest Department on the basis of marking list approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle.
7. Rent of Rs. 12,000/- (Rupees Twelve thousand only) per month is to be charged towards Government.
8. 25% increase in rent will be charged after every three years.
9. No permanent construction of building is permitted at the proposed site.
10. The user agency will furnish a bank guarantee of a Nationalized Bank equivalent to the amount of rent payable for the period of three years as a security deposit to be encashed in event of failure of the user agency to pay monthly rent regularly.
11. Before transfer of land forest department will execute an agreement with the user agency specifying all terms and conditions as laid down in the Govt. order sanctioning the diversion of forest land.
12. The possession of forest land diverted for non-forestry purpose under the orders of competent authority should not be handedover to the user agency till all payments due against various components are not received in full by the Forest Department.
13. The user agency should ensure the availability of funds under appropriate heads for making payments due to the Forest Department as per the conditions stipulated in the order of transfer of forest land.
14. Any damage done to the forests by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency at the rate of ten times the standard rate of 1992.
15. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is no longer required by the User Agency without any cost.

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16. The user agency shall submit an undertaking that in case of any upward revision of rates of Net Present Value, the user agency will pay the amount of differential Net Present Value.
17. The possession of forest land diverted for non-forestry purpose under the orders of the competent authority, should not be handed over to the user agency till all payments due against Compensation of trees, NPV/Compensation of land, Compensatory afforestation costs etc are not deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the PCCF. Before handing over the possession of the forest land it should be further ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said user agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past.

The proposal stand cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary in its 37th meeting held on 28th March, 2007.
