

GOVERNMENT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR LIVIL SECTT: FOREST DEPARTMENT.

Subject :- Diversion of 2.2115 ha of Forest Land for construction of feeder road from PIER location at P-30, P-40 of Chenab Bridge at Village Bakkal in Reasi Forest Div.

Reference: Cabinet Decision No. 89/7 dated 20.05.2008.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. 195 - FST OF 2008 D A T E D; 27 - 95 - 2008

Sanction is accorded to diversion of forest land measuring 2.2115 ha falling under Compartment No. 22/R in Block Bhomag, Range Reasi, Reasi Forest Division for construction of feeder road from PIER location at P-30, P-40 of Chenab Bridge at Village Bakkal by Northern Railway on the following terms and conditions:

1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.

The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.

3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user

agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.

The User Agency shall pay Net Present Value of the forest land to the tune of Rs. 16,58,625/- (Rs. Sixteen lacs fifty-eight thousand six hundred & twenty-five only) as calculated by the concerned DFO as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 30-10-2002 in I.A. No: 566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No: 202 of 1995 T.N. Godavarman Thirumalpad V/S Union of India.

The User Agency shall pay an amount of Rs. 1,88,439/4 (Rs. One lac eighty-eight thousand four hundred & thirty-nine only) on account of compensation of 280 no. of

trees/poles of different species dia-classes.

The User Agency shall pay Rs. 1,15,653/- (Rs. One lac fifteen thousand six hundred fifty-three only) on account of compensatory afforestation to be carried over 4.423.

7. The extraction of trees shall be done by the SFC/Forest Department on the basis of markings technically sanctioned by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle and administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu.

8. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency at the rate of ten times the standard rate of 1992.

The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.

The user agency shall construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road/railway line/earth work/tunneling etc., and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips. In this regard, the user agency shall seek technical guidance from Director, Soil Conservation Department, J&K.

11. The user agency shall also pay any other amount which will become payable as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court or Government/Forest Department, J&K.

12. The user agency shall be responsible to get requisite clearance under any other relevant law in vogue.

13. The user agency shall submit an undertaking that in case of any upward revision of rates of Net Present Value, the user agency will pay the amount of differential Net Present Value.

14. The User Agency shall clear the debris resulting from construction work from forest land or shall be bound to pay additional compensation to be worked-out by DFO

(Territorial) concerned for the damage caused to forest land, trees/poles and

regeneration by such dumping of debris.

15. The possession of Forest land diverted for non-forestry purpose under the order: of the competent authority, should not be handed over to the user agency till all payments due against Compensation of trees, NPV/Compensation of land, Compensatory afforestation costs etc are deposited with Chief Accounts Officei in the office of the PCCF. Before handing over the possession of the Forest land it should be further ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said User Agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past.

The proposal stands cleared/ approved by the Advisory Committee in its 1st meeting held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary on 25th February, 2008.
