Subject :- Proposal for cutting of 50 No of trees for widening of Sidhra Mansar road (Sidhra to Sardhan Nallah Bridge) by Economic Reconstruction Agency in Jammu Forest Div.

Reference: Cabinet Decision No. 89/7 dated 20.05.2008.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. 205 FST OF 2008 DATED;

Sanction is accorded for felling permission of \$0 no.of trees falling in Compartment No. 63, 762 (Near Social Forestry) in Block Bajalta, Range Bahu, Jammu Forest Division for widening of Sidhra Mansar road (Sidhra to Sardhan Nallah Bridge) by Economic Reconstruction Agency (ERA) on the following terms and conditions:

1. The extraction of trees shall be done by the SFC/Forest Department on the basis of markings technically sanctioned by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle and administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, concerned.

Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency at the rate of ten times the standard rate of 1992.

The User Agency shall pay an amount of Rs. 35,178/- (Rs. Thirty-five thousand one hundred & seventy-eight only) on account of compensation of 50 No. of Broad leaved trees/poles of different dia-classes.

The user agency shall also pay any other amount which will become payable as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court or Government/Forest Department, J&K.

The user agency shall be responsible to get requisite clearance under any other

relevant law in vogue.

The felling permission of marked trees will be issued by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu after receipt of all payments due i.e compensation for felling of trees etc.

The proposal stands cleared/approved by the Advisory Committee in its 41st meeting held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary on 25th February, 2008.
