Sanction is accorded to the diversion of forest land measuring 52.62 ha falling under Compartment No. 1/B,2/B,3/B,10/B,12/B,10/M,12/M,13/M in Batote Division, 33/Ch, 30/Ch,13/JWR, 12/JWR, 11/JWR, 6/JWR in Bhaderwah Division and 18/K,37/K,38/K,39/K, 67/K in Kishtwar Division for widening of Batote-Kishtwar road (NH-IB) into D/L specification by GREF authority, on the following terms and conditions:

The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.

The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.

The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user

agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.

The User Agency shall pay Net Present Value of the forest land to the tune of Rs. 3,78,73,800/- (Rs. Three Crore seventy-eight lacs seventy-three thousand eight hundred only) as calculated by the concerned DFO as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 30-10-2002 in I.A. No: 566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No: 202 of 1995 T.N. Godavarman Thirumalpad V/S Union of India.

8. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land and in case of violation of the condition, shall have to pay for the damage done to forest land/crop.

The extraction of trees shall be done by the SFC/Forest Department on the basis of markings technically sanctioned by CF, Working Plan Circle & administratively approved by the CCF, concerned.

Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency at the rate of ten 10. times the standard rate of 1992.

The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department free of any 11.

encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.

The user agency shall construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road/railway line/earth work/tunneling/Water Reservoir etc., and take other 12. necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips. In this regard, the user agency shall seek technical guidance from Director, Soil Conservation Department,

The user agency shall also pay any other amount which will become payable as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court.or Government/Forest Department, J&K.

The user agency shall be responsible to get requisite clearance under any other 14 relevant law in vogue.

The user agency shall submit an undertaking that in case of any upward revision of rates of Net Present Value, the user agency will pay the amount of differential Net Present Value

The possession of Forest land diverted for non-forestry purpose under the orders of 16. the competent authority, should not be handed over to the user agency till all payments due against Compensation of trees, NPV/Compensation of land, Compensatory afforestation costs etc are deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the PCCF. Before handing over the possession of the Forest should be further ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said User Agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past.

The proposal stands cleared/ approved by the Advisory Committee in its 41st meeting held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary on 5th, March 2008 (second supp.agenda item No. 41.44).
