Subject:-Proposal for cutting of 313 number of trees/poles coming in widening of Satwari-R.S. Pura road i.e. Miransahib to Tali Morh (KFC Training School) in Jammu Forest Division.

## GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. 35 / - FST OF 2008 D A T E D; - 69 - 2008

Sanction is accorded for cutting 313 trees/poles coming in the widening of the Satwari-R.S. Pura road i.e, Miransahib to Tali Morh (KFC Training School) in Range Bahu, Jammu Forest Division, by the PWD (R&B) on the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The User Agency shall pay an amount of Rs. 7,77,334/- (Rs. Seven lacs seventy-seven thousand three hundred thirty-four only) on account of compensation of 313 No. of trees/poles of Broad leaved species of different dia-clases (trees =189, Poles=124).
- 2. The extraction of trees shall be done by the State Forest Corporation on the basis of markings technically sanctioned by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle and administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, concerned.
- 3. Any damage done to the plantation by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency at the rate of ten times the standard rate of 1992.
- 4. The user agency shall construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the earth work, and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips. In this regard, the user agency shall seek technical guidance from Director, Soil Conservation Department, J&K.

5. The user agency shall also pay any other amount which will become payable as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court or Government/Forest Department, J&K.

- 6. The user agency shall be responsible to get requisite clearance under any other relevant law in vogue.
- 7. The money on account of Compensation of trees to be paid by the User Agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
- 8. Felling of trees shall be allowed only after the amount deposited by the User Agency is credited in the Official account of Chief Accounts Officer and information to this effect is communicated to the Divisional Forest Officer concerned by the Pr.Chief Conservator of Forests Office.

The proposal stands cleared/ approved by the Advisory Committee in its 43rd meeting held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary on 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2008 (Agenda Item No. 43.20).
