Use of 25 Ha forest land for construction of Margan Top to Inshan road (Km 0 to Km 25) by PWD (R&B) in Marwah Forest Division.

Sanction is accorded to the use of forest land measuring 25 ha falling under Compartment no.25/Marwah in Block Inshan, Range Marwah, Marwah Forest Division (Distt Kishatwar), for the construction of Margan Top to Inshan road (Km 0 to Km 25) by PWD (R&B) on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.

The forest land so allowed for use shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.

3. The forest land so allowed for use shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or subleased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.

4. The User Agency shall pay the following amount :-

i. Net Present Value = Rs. 2,24,25,000/ii. Compensation of 772 Trees/Poles = Rs. 86,59,000/-

iii. Compensatory Afforestation = Rs.1,00,00,000/iv. Cost of damaged involved = Rs. 5,39,000/-

> TOTAL = Rs.4,16,23,000/-

5. The extraction of trees/poles shall be done by the J&K State Forest Corporation on the basis of markings technically sanctioned by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle and administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, concerned.

6. The User Agency shall construct retaining/breast walls and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of road. In this regard, the User Agency shall seek technical guidance from the Director, Soil Conservation Department, J&K.

7. Any damage done to the forest land/crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.

8. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.

The User Agency shall be responsible to obtain requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.

10. The money on account of various heads to be paid by the User Agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.

The proposal stands cleared by the Advisory Committee in its meeting held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary on 28-11..2008 (Agenda item No.44.07).
