Sanction is accorded to the use of forest land measuring 2.85 hectare falling under compartment No.64/U, Block Tershi, Range Udhampur, Udhampur Forest Division (Distt. Udhampur) for laying of 33 KV Transmission Line from Jekhani PDD Grid Station (Udhampur) to Rec. Station Command Hospital, Udhampur by Power Development Department on the following terms and conditions:-

- 1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- 3. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
- 4. The User Agency shall pay the following amount :
 - i. Net Present Value

= Rs. 24,08,250/-

ii. Compensation of 922 Trees/Poles

= Rs. 3,02,632/-

TOTAL

= Rs.27,10,882/-

- 5. The User Agency shall abide by the following:-
 - Below each conductor, width clearance of 3 Mtr. would be permitted for taking tension stringing equipment.
 - ii. In the remaining width of Corridor, trees will be felled or lopped to the extent required for preventing electrical hazards by maintaining a minimum clearance between conductors and trees as 2.80 Mtr.
 - iii. In the stretches where terrain is hilly and adequate clearance is already available, trees will not be cut.
- 6. The extraction of trees/poles shall be done by the J&K State Forest Conservation on the basis of markings technically sanctioned by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle and administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, concerned.
- 7. The User Agency shall not be allowed to dump the debris (resulted from the excavation of foundation for the towers) on forest land.
- 8. Any damage done to the forest land/crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.

9. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.

10. The User Agency shall be responsible to obtain requisite clearances under any

other law in vogue.

11. The money on account of various heads to be paid by the User Agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of Pr.Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.

The proposal stands cleared by the Advisory Committee in its 44th meeting held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary on 28.11.2008 (Agenda item No.44.15).
