**Subject:- Use of 0.05 hectare of forest land for construction of CRPF Barrack near Helipad at Anji Bridge site by Northern Railways in Reasi Forest Division.**

**Reference: State Administrative Council decision No. 98/8/2008 dated 11.12.2008.**

**Government Order No. 979 FST of 2008**

**D a t e d : 19 -12 - 2008**

Sanction is accorded to the use of forest land measuring 0.05 hectare falling under compartment no.37/R, Block Tote, Range Reasi, Reasi Forest Division (Distt. Reasi) for construction of CRPF Barrack near Helipad at Anji Bridge site by Northern Railways on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been intended.
3. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. The User Agency shall pay the following amount :-
  - i. Net Present Value = Rs. 32,850/-
  - ii. Compensation of 11Poles. = Rs. 2,113/-

**TOTAL = Rs. 34,963/-**
5. The User Agency shall take all necessary steps to check soil erosion likely to occur due to proposed construction of Barrack.
6. Any damage done to the forest land/crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
7. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.
8. The User Agency shall be responsible to obtain requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.
9. The money on account of various heads to be paid by the User Agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of Pr.Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.

The proposal stands cleared by the Advisory Committee in its 44<sup>th</sup> meeting held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary on 28.11.2008 (Agenda item No.44.11).
