Sanction is accorded to the use of forest land measuring 6.085 hectare falling under Compt. No. 41,42,43 & 44/Rbn Block, Ramban, Range Ramban, Ramban Forest Division (Distt. Ramban) for construction of road from Marog to Adhwa by Executive Engineer, PMGSY Div. Doda-I Batote on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.

2. The forest land so allowed for use shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.

3. The forest land so allowed for use shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.

4. The User Agency shall pay the following amount :-

i. Net Present Value

= Rs. 42,53,415

ii. Compensation of 681 T/P/S

= Rs. 26,80,553

iii. Compensatory Afforestation

= Rs. 3,00,000

Total

= <u>Rs. 72,33,968</u>

- 5. The extraction of trees/poles will be done by J&K State Forest Corporation after the markings are technically sanctioned by the Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle and administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, concerned.
- 6. The User Agency shall construct Retaining/Breast walls and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. The User Agency shall seek technical guidance in this respect from the Director, J&K Soil Conservation Deptt.
- 7. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land other than that allowed for use.
 - 8. Any damage done to the forest land/crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
 - 9. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and it is rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
 - 10. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.
 - 11. The money on account of various heads to be paid by the User Agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of Pr.Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.

The proposal stands cleared by the Advisory Committee in its 45th meeting held on 9.3..2009 (Agenda item No.45.05).
