## GOVERNMENT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR CIVIL SECTT. FOREST DEPARTMENT.

Proposal to allow use of 15.39 hectare of forest land for four-laning of NH-1A from Manthal to Flata by NHAI in Udhampur Forest Division.

Reference: Cabinet Decision No. 65/6/2009 dated 13.06.2009.

Government Order No. 26/ FST of 2009
Dated: 19-66-2009

Sanction is accorded to the use of 15.39 ha of forest land falling under compartment No. 13, 14 & 16/U, Block Gudhair Sangial, Range Udhampur, Udhampur Forest Division (Distt. Udhampur) in favour of the Project Director, National Highway Authority of India, Project Implementation Unit, Jammu for four laning of NH-1A from Manthal to Flata by NHAI, on the following terms and conditions:-

- 1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- 3. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
- 4. The User Agency shall pay the following amount :
  - i. Net Present Value = Rs. 1,34,69850
  - ii. Compensation of 2810 T/P/S = Rs. 12,11,330
  - iii. Compensatory Afforestation = Rs. 7,74,500
  - iv. Cost of damage of fencing = Rs. 98,444

Total = Rs. 1,55,54,124

- 5. The extraction of trees/poles will be done by J&K State Forest Corporation after the markings are technically sanctioned by the Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle and administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, concerned.
- The User Agency shall construct Retaining/Breast walls and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed widening of the road. The User Agency shall seek technical guidance in this respect from the Director, J&K Soil Conservation Deptt.

The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land.

- Any damage done to the forest land/crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- 9. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and it is rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
- 10. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.
- 11. The money on account of various heads to be paid by the User Agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of Pr.Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
