Sanction is accorded to use of 17.784 hac. of Forest land for Construction of Road from Banihal (Amkot) to Mangit (KM. 08 PMGSY falling in Compartments 36,37a,38,39,40 & 41/Bnl. in Ramban Forest Division, District i. Proprietary status of Forest land shall

remain unchanged

ii. The Forest land shall be utilized for the purpose for which it has been indented.

iii. The Forest land in question shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what soever to any other agency

The user agency shall pay Rs. 2,72,12,013/- out of iv. which Rs, 1,59,52,248/- shall be net present value, Rs. 1,03,59,765/- as compensation for 1784 T/P and Rs. 9,00,000/- as compensatory afforestration.

Extraction of 1784 trees/poles coming in the said land v. shall be done by the State Forest Corporation after the markings are technically sanctioned by the Conservator of Forests and Administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests concerned

vi. The user Agency shall construct retaining/breast walls and take all necessary steps to check Soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. The user agency shall seek technical guidance in this respect from the Director, J&K Soil Conservation Department.

The user Agency shall not dump the debris (resulting from construction work) on Forest land or shall be bound to pay additional compensation to be worked out by the DFO (Territorial) concerned for the damage done.

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- Any damage done to the Forest land/crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- The Forest land so allowed for use shall return to the ix. Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the user agency and after it is rehabilitated properly by the user agency.

The user agency shall be responsible for obtaining X. requisite clearances under any other Law in vogue.

- The possession of the Forest land diverted for non xi. forestry purpose under the orders of the Competent Authority shall not be handed over to the user agency till all payments due against compensation of trees, NPV/compensation of land, compensatory afforestration costs are deposited with the forest department. Before handing over the possession of the land in question it should be further ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said user agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past
- The amount on account of various Heads to be paid by xii. the user agency as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
