Sub:- Diversion of 7.20 hac. of Forest land for Construction of Road from Bagga (Angralla) to Gulabgarh (Kilometer 10 to Kilometer 27.500) under PMGSY in Mohore Forest Division.

Sanction is accorded to use of 7.20 hac. of Forest land for Construction of Road from Bagga (Angralla) to Gulabgarh (Kilometer 10 to Kilometer 27.500) under PMGSY in Compartments No. 15,16,27,33/GG Mohore Forest Division District Reasi; *subject to following conditions:-*

- i. Proprietary status of Forest land shall remain unchanged
- ii. The Forest land shall be utilized for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- iii. The Forest land in question shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what soever to any other agency
- iv. The user agency shall pay Rs. 9701072/- out of which Rs. 6458400/- shall be net present value, Rs. 2822852/- as compensation for 1654 T/P and Rs. 419820/- as compensatory afforestation.
- v. Extraction of 1654 trees/poles coming in the said land shall be done by the State Forest Corporation after the markings are technically sanctioned by the Conservator of Forests and Administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests concerned
- vi. The user Agency shall construct retaining/breast walls and take all necessary steps to check Soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. The user agency shall seek technical guidance in this respect from the Director, J&K Soil Conservation Department.
- vii. The user Agency shall not dump the debris (resulting from construction work) on Forest land or shall be bound to pay additional compensation to be worked out by the DFO (Territorial) concerned for the damage done.

- viii. Any damage done to the Forest land/crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- ix. The Forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the user agency and after it is rehabilitated properly by the user agency.
- x. The user agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other Law in vogue.
- xi. The possession of the Forest land diverted for non forestry purpose under the orders of the Competent Authority shall not be handed over to the user agency till all payments due against compensation of trees, NPV/compensation of land, compensatory afforestation costs are deposited with the forest department. Before handing over the possession of the land in question it should be further ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said user agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past
- xii. The amount on account of various Heads to be paid by the user agency as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
