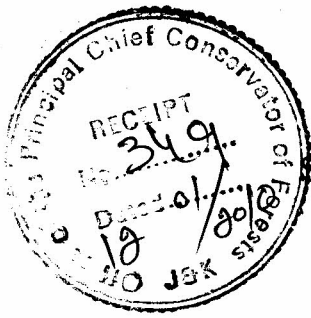

Sanction is hereby accorded to diversion of 4.765 hac. of Forest Land from Compartments No. 98/D & 99/D Nowshera Forest Division in District Reasi for improvement of Bharakh-Ransu-Ascon Site (KM 7.925 to KM 28.350) from CL-5 un-surface to C-I 9 Surface specification by GREF, on following terms and conditions: -

- I. The Proprietary status of Forest land shall remain unchanged.
- II. The Forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- III. The Forest land in question shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner whatsoever to any other agency.
- IV. The user agency shall pay the following amount: -

i	Net Present Value	= Rs. 40,26,425/-
ii	Compensation for 350 T/P	=Rs. 20,57,118/-
iii	Compensatory Afforestation	=Rs. 2,38,300/-

- V. The Extraction of 350 trees/poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation on the basis of markings technically sanctioned by the Conservator of Forests and administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests concerned.
- VI. The user Agency shall construct retaining/breast walls and take all necessary steps to check Soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. The user agency shall seek technical guidance in this respect from the Director, J&K Soil Conservation Department.
- VII. The user Agency shall not dump the debris on the Forest land.

- VIII. Any damage done to the Forest land/Crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- IX. The Forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the user agency and after it is rehabilitated properly by the user agency.
- X. The user agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other Law in vogue.
- XI. The possession of the Forest land diverted for non forestry purpose above shall not be handed over to the user agency till all payments due on account of NPV/compensation of land, compensatory afforestation costs, are deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests J&K. Before handing over the possession of the land in question it should further be ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said user agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past.
