Sub: - Diversion of 60.4722 hac. of Forest land for laying of 132 KV, D/C Ramban- Khillani-Kishtwar T/L by PDD.

## Government Order No: 13 - FST of 2010 D a t e d: 11/01/2010

Sanction is hereby accorded to diversion of 60 4722 Hac. of Forest land in compartments No. 47/Rbn, 28,23,14,13,1/Bat & 13 Marmat, 38/Kunt, 33/Ch, 32/Ch, 30/Ch, 12/Jwr, 48/Bh & 1/M, 18,37,39 & 67/K of Ramban, Batote, Doda, Bhaderwah & Kishtwar Forest Divisions for laying of 132 KV D/C Ramban- Khillani-Kishtwar T/L by PDD, on following terms and conditions: -

I. The Proprietary status of the Forest land shall remain unchanged

II. The Forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.

- III. The Forest land in question shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what soever to any other agency.
- IV. The user agency shall pay Rs. 5,42,55,406/- out of which Rs, 4,67,71,485/- shall be net present value, and Rs. 44,55,921/- on account of compensation of 2807 Trees/Poles/Saplings, Rs. 30,25,000/- for compensatory afforestration and Rs. 3000/- for other damages.
- V. The user agency shall also abide by the following: -

- i. Below each conductor, width clearance of 03 Mtr. Would be permitted for taking tension stringing equipment
- ii. In the remaining width of Corridor, trees will be felled or lopped to the extent required for preventing electrical hazards by maintaining a minimum clearance between conductors and trees as 4.00 Mtr.
- iii. In the stretches where terrain is hilly and adequate clearance is already available, trees will not be cut
- VI. The Extraction of minimum possible Number of trees up to 2807 trees/poles coming in the said land shall be done by the State Forest Corporation after the markings are technically sanctioned by the Conservator of Forests and administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, concerned as per breakup given below: -

- VII. The user agency shall not be allowed to dump the debris (resulting from excavation of foundation for the towers) on Forest land.
- VIII. Any damage done to the Forest land/Crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
  - IX. The Forest land so diverted for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the user agency and after it is rehabilitated properly by the user agency.

- X. The user agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other Law in vogue.
- XI. The possession of the Forest land diverted for non forestry purpose above shall not be handed over to the user agency till all payments due on account of NPV/compensation of land, compensatory afforestration costs, are deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests J&K. Before handing over the possession of the land in question it should further be ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said user agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past
