Sub: - Diversion of 16.1 hac. of Forest land (already under the occupation of Army since 1999) for purpose of Ammunition point and supply Depot at Rekha-I, Karnah in Kehmil Forest Division.

**Government Order No: 14 - FST of 2010**

Sanction is hereby accorded to diversion of 16.1 Hac. Of Forest land in compartment No. 32/Kh of Kehmil Forest Division (already under the occupation of Army since 1999) for purpose of Ammunition point and supply Depot (16 Bihar, C/o 56 APO) at Rekha-I, Karnah in District Kupwara, on following terms and conditions: -

- I. The Proprietary status of the Forest land shall remain unchanged
- II. The Forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- III. The Forest land in question shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what soever to any other agency.
- IV. The user agency shall pay Rs. 1,52,46,700/- out of which Rs, 1,44,41,700/- shall be net present value, and Rs. 8,05,000/- as compensatory afforestation.
- V. The felling of trees in the area shall not be permitted.
- VI. Any damage done to the Forest land/crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- VII. The Forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the user agency and after it is rehabilitated properly by the user agency.
- VIII. The user agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other Law in vogue.

IX. The possession of the Forest land diverted for non forestry purpose above shall not be handed over to the user agency till all payments due on account of NPV/compensation of land, compensatory afforestation costs, are deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests J&K. Before handing over the possession of the land in question it should further be ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said user agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past
