Sub: - Diversion of 22.20 hectare of forest land for laying of 400 KV/SC Transmission line from Uri to Uri-II & Uri-II to Wagoora by Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd. in I.V. Forest Division.

Sanction is hereby accorded to diversion for laying of 400 KV/SC Transmission line from Uri to Uri-II & Uri-II to Wagoora by Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd. falling in compartments No. 70,71, 03,02/Bla, 20,22/Kathali & 17/Uri in J.V. Forest Division, District Baramulla on following terms and conditions: -

- I. The Proprietary and legal status of Forest land shall remain unchanged.
- II. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- III. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
- IV. The user agency shall pay the following amount after the forest clearance is accorded: -

i.	Net Present value	Rs. 2,20,00,200/-
ii.	Compensation for 11976 (trees + Poles+ Saplings)	Rs. 2,17,34,372/-
iii.	Compensatory Afforestation	Rs. 18,32,000/-

- V. The extraction of 11976 ( Trees, Poles & Saplings) shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/ Forest Department on the basis of marking administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, concerned. The Cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
- VI. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. The User Agency shall seek technical guidance in this respect from the Director, J&K Soil Conservation Department. A copy of the plan and design of the proposed road shall be made available to the Forest Department.
- VII. The user Agency shall not dump the debris on the Forest land and it be dumped in separate dumping sites. Area of dumping sites will be included for additional diversion by the User Agency.
- VIII. Any damage done to the Forest by his user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from user agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- IX. The Forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the user agency and after it is rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.

- X. The user agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other Law in vogue.
- XI. The money on account of various heads to be paid by the User Agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of Principal Chief Conservator of forests, J&K.
- XII. The possession of the Forest land diverted for non forestry purpose above shall not be handed over to the user agency till all payments due on account of NPV/compensation of land, compensatory afforestation costs, are deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests J&K. Before handing over the possession of the land in question it should further be ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said user agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past.




