Sanction is accorded to felling of 496 poles/ saplings of Social Forestry Department (RDF with Co. 84b/Sj) involved in the construction of Beoli to Gaddi road under PMGSY in Doda Forest Division on the following terms and conditions: -

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount.

i.	Comp. of Poles / Saplings	=Rs. 34,960/-
ii	Re-planting Charges	=Rs. 3,532/-
iii	Cost of damage to fencing	=Rs. 67,655/-
Total		=Rs. 1,06,147/-

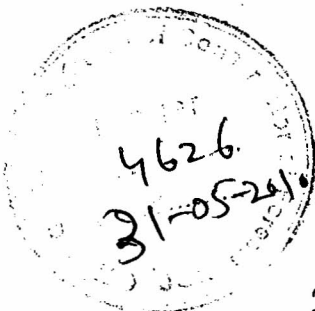
2. The extraction of poles/ saplings shall be done by the State Forest Department (SFD)/ State Forest Corporation (SFC) on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Director, Social Forestry Department, J&K. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency

3. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from User Agency @ Ten times the standard rates of 1992.

4. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.

5. The amount on account of various Heads to be paid by the user agency as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.


