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Sub: - Diversion of 3.75 hectare of Forest land for setting-up of "Modern Abattoir" at Jagti (Nagrota) by Jammu Municipal Corporation in Jammu Forest Division.

**Government Order No: 297 - FST of 2010**

Sanction is hereby accorded to diversion of 3.75 hectare of Forest land for setting-up of "Modern Abattoir" at Jagti (Nagrota) by Jammu Municipal Corporation in Jammu Forest Division, on following terms and conditions: -

- a) The Proprietary status of Forest land shall remain unchanged.
- b) The Forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- c) The Forest land in question shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner whatsoever to any other agency.
- d) The user agency shall pay the following amount: -

i	Net Present Value	=Rs. 35,21,250/-
ii	Compensation for 253 Trees/Poles	=Rs. 1,90,943/-
iii	Compensatory Afforestation	=Rs. 3,75,000/-
<b>Total</b>		<b>40,87,193/-</b>

- e) The Extraction of 253 Trees/Poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation on the basis of the markings technically sanctioned by the Conservator of Forests and administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests concerned.
- f) The user agency shall also abide by the following:

- i) *The JMC shall ensure fulfillment of all conditions laid down by the Pollution Control Board.*
- ii) *The JMC shall organize interactive sessions with the people residing in adjoining villages providing them full details about the project and informing them about various Pollution Control measures to be taken. Local administration viz Tehsildar, SDPO should also be associated for this*

iii) The JMC shall raise high boundary walls on all sides with heavy plantation along boundary wall. In addition, additional plantation of appropriate species should also be done within the campus in consultation with forest department.

Any damage done to the Forest land/Crop shall be charged @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.

The Forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the user agency and after it is rehabilitated properly by the user agency.

The user agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other Law in vogue.

The amount on account of various Heads to be paid by the user agency as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
